FROM THE GREENKEEPER

Dear Residents and Members,

Why do we hollowtyne? The answers are varied and can lead to heated debates among golfers and turf managers.

My short answer is that it is the single biggest maintenance function we can perform to rejuvenate the greens. By the end of December, we are fighting poor root growth, poor water infiltration and massive disease pressure all due to compacted conditions from pushing the greens hard for 12 months. Just a reminder the green is still comprised of a living plant that is mowed at ridiculously short heights. That plant still has to take up nutrients, water and transpire while being hammered by golfers, the weather and machinery. Hollowtyning gives the grass a break by easing all the pressures and returning the growing conditions to fairly normal limits.

You can almost hear them sigh with relief.

We add the interseeding to introduce a population of new and improved variety of bent that should be able to handle all the stress better than the original variety. This coupled with our Poa program has resulted in greens that we can be consistently proud of.

The process works.
