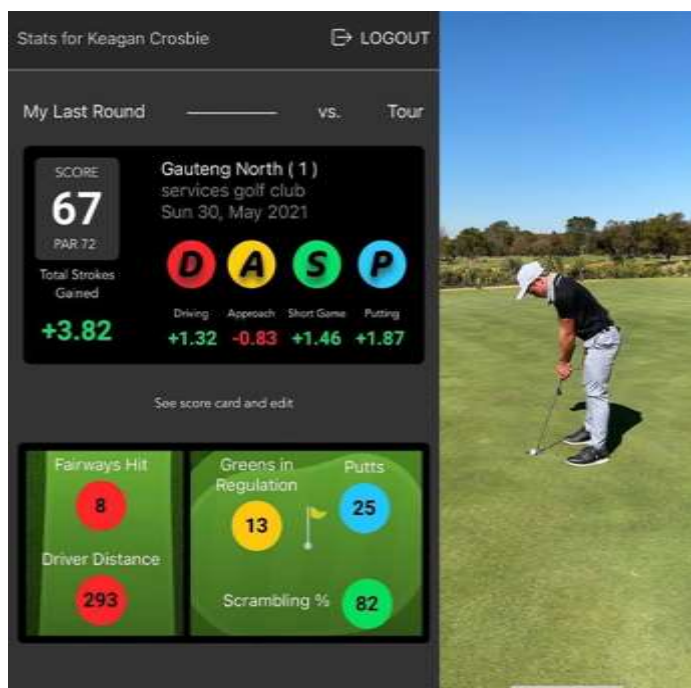
PHELAN GOLF ACADEMY
