

Keagan Crosbie stepping up his game.



PHELAN GOLF ACADEMY



Let's take about takeaways, no not the juice burger for lunch but the one that matters in a good golf swing.

Your instinct will always be to get the clubs center of mass back to the golf ball.


Outside:

If the club centre of mass is to far outside, it will reroute back underneath its back swing motion (Matthew Wolff). Path in to out and shallow angle of attack.



Inside:

The clubs centre of mass will try get back to the ball by moving over the top. Path out to in and steeper angle of attack.

Sending

- 1. Download the Pudo SA app and register.
- 2. Load funds to your account.
- 3. Book your parcel from the comfort of your home.
- 4. Write your delivery address on the parcel.
- 5. Place the parcel in the locker by scanning the provided QR code.
- 6. We will then collect the parcel and deliver it to the requested destination.

Collecting

- 1. Recipient will receive a text, email or app notification when parcel is ready to be collected.
- 2. Go to your chosen Parcel Locker, scan the QR code provided (or enter the unique pin code provided)
- 3. Your locker will open. Remove your parcel.
