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Advertising and promotions

- Advertising branding is allowed on the golf course and around the clubhouse. Vehicles are not permitted on the golf course, only tarred roads may be used, and display cars must be parked at least two meters from any tee.
- Please note we do not take responsibility for any loss or damage to banners or promotional items. Additionally, we are unable to store any banners or equipment before or after your golf day, as we do not have storage facilities.
- Lastly, please refrain from handing out items (e.g., caps, shirts, money or alcoholic beverages) to our staff members or caddies.

Watering holes

- Hole 5: Equipped with a thatched lapa, electricity, water, cement bar counter, and a bathroom (door code: C16XYZ).
- Holes 3 and 15: Each is equipped with a thatched lapa. Hole 15 also has a nearby bathroom.
- Additional watering holes may be arranged with the Events Manager, however they will not have the same facilities as these three designated holes.
- **Please note:** No watering holes or sponsors are permitted on hole 11.
- We recommend a maximum of six alcoholic watering holes. Sponsors are responsible for providing staff to manage their allocated stations. Each sponsored station must supply its own tables, tablecloths, chairs, and drinks buckets.
- **Important:** If drinks or dry snacks from outside are supplied at a sponsored hole, a corkage fee of R 3 500.00 per hole will be added to your bill (subject to change). If any form of food (e.g. burgers, boerewors rolls) is served at a sponsored hole, a surcharge of R 6 000.00 will be added to your invoice. The Club's halfway house must be fully supported, as the kitchen will be preparing food for all golfers and guests.
- A roaming drinks cart will circulate throughout the day, with ice bags available for purchase.

Availability of stock: (ordered through Centurion Country Club watering hole list)

- If you require the club to supply drinks and snacks for your sponsored hole, please submit your watering hole order list at least 5 days prior to the event.
- All required stock will be prepared and ready 1 hour before the tee-off time. No additional stock will be provided after 15:00. The client is responsible for checking and signing for all drinks issued by the F&B department for the watering holes. Beverages will be charged based on actual consumption.
- Only drinks in their original six-pack packaging can be returned. Loose items or broken six-packs, savoury snacks, chocolates, candy, and crisps are non-returnable. All leftover items must be taken with you at the end of the day.
- It is the client's responsibility to obtain the F&B department's signature for any returned stock. The client remains responsible for all stock until it is returned to the club's stores.

Dangerous objects or activities

- Noise and safety: You are required to keep all noise levels, including music, to a minimum.
- No dangerous objects or activities of whatsoever nature will be permitted in particular but not limited to the watering holes or any other holes on the golf course or in and around the clubhouse and its facilities.
- Dangerous objects shall include but not be limited to objects such as firearms, including pellet guns, bows and arrows, crossbows, knives, spears, and darts.
- No dangerous objects or activities are allowed at any time on the course or clubhouse.

Bar requirements

- No food or drinks from outside may be brought into the clubhouse for consumption.
- Our corkage fees are as follows: R 80.00 per bottle of wine, R 150.00 per bottle of local sparkling wine (MCC), R 300.00 per bottle of French champagne, R 450.00 per bottle for specialty beverages valued under R 5 000.00, R 1 000.00 per bottle for specialty beverages valued over R 5 000.00.
- Corkage applies if we are not able to source the required beverages, otherwise full club selling price will be charged for any beverages brought in.
- Bar options: No drink vouchers will be accepted.
- Wine can be chosen and placed on the tables for prize giving, and it will be charged to the main account.

- Please confirm whether the bar will operate on a cash basis or on an account. If an account is required, kindly specify the approved limit.

- The club supplies standard white or black tablecloths and serviettes for either round tables or rectangular trestle tables.

- Important notice: The clubhouse is a smoke-free zone. The organiser of the golf day will be held responsible for any guests who smoke inside the venue.

- Our kitchen prepares food based on the confirmed number of attendees for the buffet stations; therefore, takeaways are not permitted.
- To ensure professional and efficient service at your prize giving function, the club partners with an outsourced company for function waiters. We require one waiter for every ten guests, which is compulsory for all functions and will be added to your invoice.

- A 50% deposit is required to secure and confirm your booking within seven days of when your quotation was sent.

- This is a holding deposit and will be deducted off your final account.



Please note that Centurion Country Club reserves the right to charge a cancellation fee, which will be calculated as a percentage of your golf day as follows:

- Notice before 60 days prior to the golf day: No cancellation fee.
- Notice within 60 – 31 days prior: 30% of the total cost.
- Notice within 30 –14 days prior: 50% of the total cost.
- Notice within less than 14 days prior: 100% of the total cost.

LOCAL RULES AND DRESS CODE

CENTURION COUNTRY CLUB - LOCAL RULES

OUT OF BOUNDS

- All estate boundary fence/walls
- Beyond all white stakes
- White stakes on the left of the 4th hole indicate out of bounds on the 4th hole only
- All estate roads and beyond excluding service roads

WATER HAZARDS

- Lateral water hazards are water or portions thereof which are demarcated with red stakes
- All other water hazards on the course demarcated by yellow stakes

DROP ZONES

- 8th hole - In front of 8th ladies tee
- 9th hole - On the fairway over the water

TREES

- A ball may be dropped away from all young trees which have a white tag and are under 2 club lengths in height – no penalty.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

- Paved or cemented pathways
- Bridges

WASTE BUNKERS

- The sandy areas with plants, vegetation and rocks at hole 11 is a waste bunker and players may ground their clubs without penalty. Loose impediments may also be removed without penalty.

GARDENS

- Relief may be taken from all gardens marked with a blue stake. Drop nearest point of relief – not nearer the hole. No penalty.
- Stones in bunkers may be removed – no penalty.

PLACING

- Check notice board

MOTORIZED GOLF CARTS

- Check notice board

NOTE

- A ball coming to rest in private property is deemed to be a lost ball. You may NOT retrieve it. Please respect our resident's privacy.

GOLFERS DRESS CODE

Please attach this document to your invitations.

Centurion Country Club's dress code complies with the SAGA (South African Golf Association) regulations. We request our members and visitors to comply with the regulations:

GOLFERS DRESS CODE ON THE COURSE

- No jeans
- Trousers with zips – no drawstring pants
- Short socks may be worn with golf shorts – no secret socks
- Recognized golf shirts with collars only
- Golf shoes only – soft spikes
- NO 'TAKKIES' are permitted!! – ONLY GOLF SHOES WITH SOFT SPIKES
- No walking around bare feet or in socks will be allowed after golf
- SHARING OF CLUBS: Sharing of clubs is not permitted at Centurion Country Club

CLUBHOUSE DRESS CODE

- Smart casual only. Please note that children are required to be neatly dressed and under control of an adult whilst in the clubhouse.
