OUT OF BOUNDS

- a) All estate boundary fences/walls.
- b) Beyond all white stakes.
- c) White stakes on the left of the 4th hole indicate out of bounds *only* on the 4th hole.
- d) All estate roads and beyond, excluding service roads.

WATER HAZARDS

- a) Lateral water hazards are water or portions thereof, demarcated with red stakes.
- b) All other water hazards on the course are demarcated by yellow stakes.

DROP ZONES

- a) 8th hole - In front of the 8th ladies' tee.
- b) 9th hole - In front of the 9th men's tee.

TREES

A ball may be dropped away from all young trees which have a white tag and are under 2 club lengths in height, with no penalty.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

- a) Paved or cemented pathways.
- b) Bridges.

WASTE BUNKERS

The sandy areas with plants, vegetation, and rocks at hole 11 are considered a waste bunker. Players may ground their clubs without penalty, and loose impediments may also be removed without penalty.

GARDENS

Relief may be taken from all gardens marked with a blue stake. Drop nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole, with no penalty. Stones in bunkers may be removed without penalty.

PLACING

Check the Notice Board for updates.

MOTORIZED GOLF CARTS

Check the Notice Board for updates.

SHARING OF CLUBS

Sharing of clubs is not permitted at Centurion Country Club.

NOTE

A ball coming to rest in private property is deemed a lost ball. You may *NOT* retrieve it. Please respect the privacy of our residents.

GOLFERS DRESS CODE: Please attach this document to your invitations.

Centurion Country Club's Dress Code complies with the SAGA (South African Golf Association) regulations. We request all members and visitors to adhere to the following:

Golfers Dress Code on the Course

- No jeans.
- Trousers with zips – no drawstring pants.
- Short socks may be worn with golf shorts – no secret socks.
- Recognized golf shirts with collars only.
- Golf shoes only – soft spikes.
- **NO 'TAKKIES'** are permitted – only golf shoes with soft spikes.
- No walking barefoot or in socks will be allowed after golf.

Clubhouse Dress Code

Smart casual only. Children are required to be neatly dressed and must be under the supervision of an adult while in the clubhouse.
